Benefits of being a FOLGA Golf Club member:

We play a different course every month, most of them in the Inland Empire.

We have outings ever month, usually on the first Saturday of the month, and all of our outings are "shotgun start" starting between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m.

The great fees charged at each outing are the course greens charged to the golf club (rounded up the nearest \$5) and an additional \$10 for the closest-to-the-pin contest. Proceeds from the contest are donated the City of Hope Cancer Research Institute.

We play 4 closest-to-the-pin contests at every outing, and a player can only win once. Therefore are 4 CTP winners at each outing.

Members can earn credits in various ways:

- Bringing in a guest to an outing (\$5 per guest)
- Recommending a new member (\$10 for each new member)
- Playing in an outing on their birthday month (\$10)
- By having the lowest team net score at an outing (\$10 for each member in the group)
- Finishing in the top 5 in the *FOLGA Cup* at the end of the year. First place gets \$125, second place gets \$75 and 3^{rd} , 4^{th} and 5^{th} place gets \$50.

Our membership dues are: **\$60** per year which includes SCGA index.

You don't have to be member to play at any given FOLGA outing. Guests are always welcome to play, and are eligible to participate the closest-to-the-pin contests.

FOLGA Cup point details:

Points are accumulated for each outing throughout the year. Each player gets 5 FOLGA Cup points for playing at an outing and 5 additional points for each participant they "beat". For example: For an outing with 20 players, the person that finishes in 1st place gets 100 points, second place get 95 points and so on.

The FOLGA Cup champion is determined by the player that accumulates the highest number of points in 5 outings: Their best 4 outings plus the Club Championship outing held at the end of the year. Points are doubled in the Club Championship outing.
